## \* CANCER AWARENESS: One Day Workshop

A guest lecture on cervical cancer awareness was held on 30th January 2025 in collaboration with Women's Doctor Wing and IMA Yavatmal.



Dr Sangeeta Ashish Tawade, president of Women's Doctor Wing and IMA Yavatmal, discussed the prevalence of cervical cancer in



India, which contributes to 6-29% of all cancers in women. Cervical cancer is the fourth most common cancer globally, with the highest rates in low- and middle-income countries.



The disease is caused by persistent infection with the human papillomavirus (HPV), with women living with HIV being six times more likely to develop it compared to women without HIV. Prophylactic vaccination and screening for precancer lesions are effective strategies to prevent cervical cancer. Countries worldwide are working to accelerate the elimination of cervical cancer, with three targets to be met by 2030. Prevention strategies include boosting public awareness, access to information and services, vaccination at age 9-14, screening at age 30 or 25 for women living with HIV, and regular cervical cancer screenings.

Regular cervical cancer screening is crucial, even for those vaccinated against HPV. Self-collection of HPV samples is reliable, and healthcare providers can identify precancers on the cervix that may develop into cervical cancer if left untreated. Treatment for precancers is simple and prevents cervical cancer, and can be offered in the same visit or after a second test, especially for women living with HIV. Treatment steps include colposcopy, thermal ablation, cryotherapy, LEETZ, and cone biopsy.

She shared the prevention like Boosting public awareness, access to information and services



disease, which when treated, also prevents cervical cancer. At any age with symptoms or concerns, early detection followed by prompt quality treatment can cure cervical cancer. After the session students and faculty members asked the queries related with the topic and vote of thanks deliverd by Miss R U Chavan and guest lecture co-ordinated by Mr Akash Dhoke.
